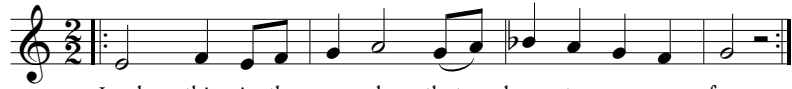

If organ is used, solo sections in the interludes are suggested.
